- Any box may be used as a ballot box

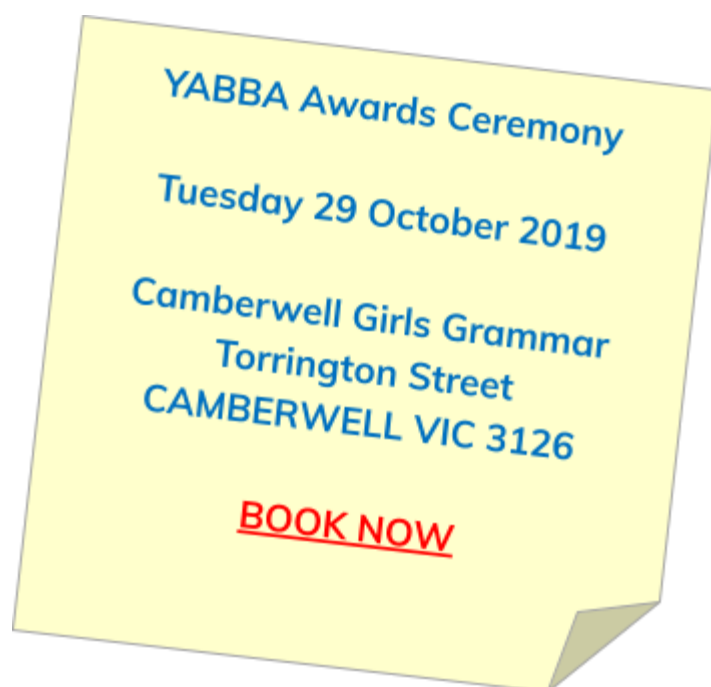
