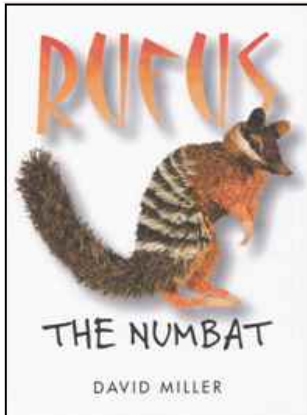

# SPOT THE DIFFERENCE

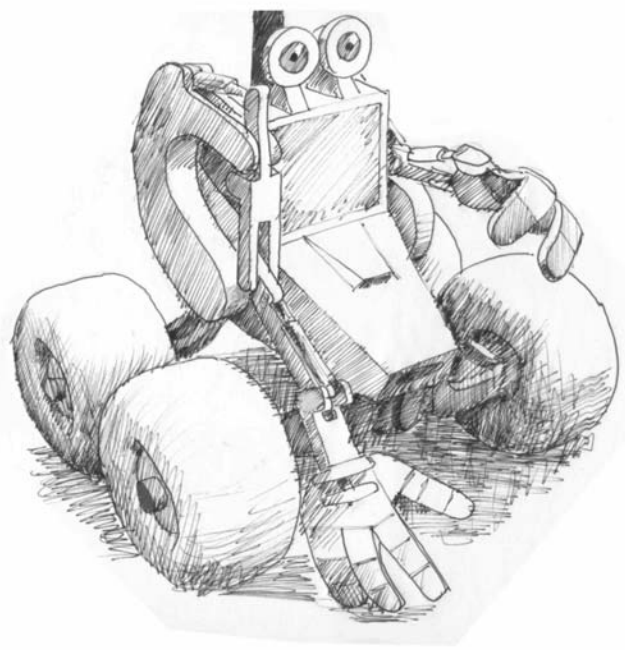
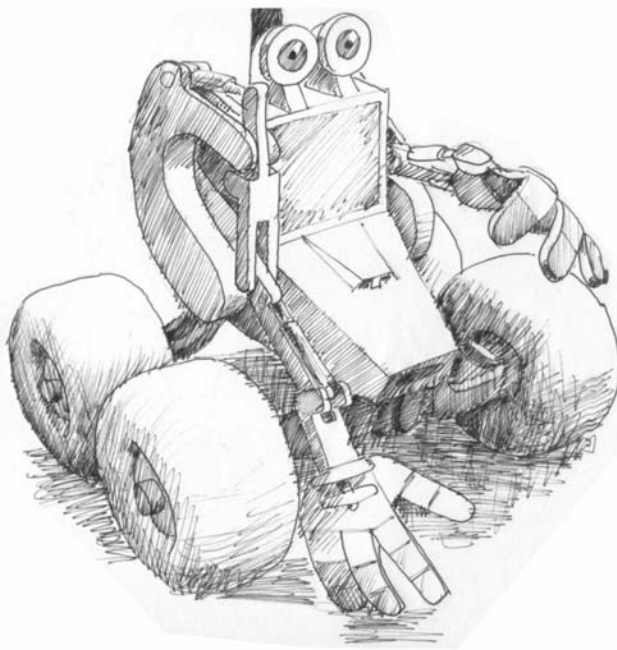


### RUFUS THE NUMBAT
